

FUNDING PROPOSALS AND APPLICATIONS

The Wareham School Committee encourages the administration and staff to seek all possible sources of state, federal, and other funds that will enhance the educational opportunities for the children in the Wareham Public Schools.

The Superintendent and/or designees will maintain awareness, seek out, and coordinate the development of proposals of all possible funds available to the school system under the various state and federal programs, and the manner these funds may best be used in the Wareham School District. The Superintendent is directed and authorized to sign all reports required for grants and will be responsible for the proper expenditure of grant funds received. Grants shall be expended in accordance with the proposal. The Superintendent shall make periodic reports to the Committee regarding the expenditure of grants. No expenditure intended to be funded by grants shall be authorized or obligated prior to actual receipt of such funds or an authorized written funding commitment. No money shall be paid by a grantor directly to an employee or vendor without the express prior authorization by the Superintendent of such obligation for payment.

The Committee alone shall have the authority to accept gifts, whether of money, goods or services. Gifts shall be expended with the approval of the Committee. No expenditure intended to be funded by gifts shall be authorized or obligated prior to actual receipt of such funds. No money shall be paid by a donor directly to an employee or vendor without the express prior authorization by the Committee of such obligation for payment.
