
WAREHAM HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

CRITERIA FOR INDUCTION

1. Eligibility is restricted to varsity athletic participants and coaches.
2. Athletic candidates under consideration for entry into the Hall of Fame must have graduated from Wareham High School. Others may be considered under mitigating circumstances.
3. No athletic candidates shall be considered until a period of ten (10) years has elapsed after his/her graduation.
4. A maximum of eight (8) candidates shall be considered for induction each year.
5. Coaching candidates must have coached at Wareham High School for a minimum of five (5) years.
6. Coaching candidates may be considered immediately upon the termination of their coaching career at Wareham High School.
7. All inductees must be respected members of society.
8. Anyone may nominate an individual for induction. All nominees will be voted on by Board Members.
9. All formal nominations shall be made at a Hall of Fame Board meeting by a Board Member.
10. If a Board Member or relative is nominated, said member shall not be present during the discussion or voting procedure of said candidate.
11. The voting procedure for nominees will be a ranking system where each Board Member will individually rank each nominee. Ranking will be totaled for each nominee to determine selection to the Hall during a preliminary and final vote.
12. Amendments to these specifications may be made by a majority vote of members present at a Hall of Fame meeting.
13. Nominees will remain active on the ballot for three (3) consecutive years, provided they get a minimum of 20 points. If he/she does not receive the minimum required points, said nominee will be removed from the ballot.
