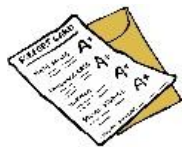

Yearbooks

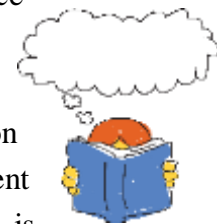
