

CHILD CUSTODY

The school shall assume that each parent/guardian has legal custody of a child unless the school principal is provided with legal documentation indicating other circumstances.

Dismissal of a child to an individual other than a parent or guardian will not be permitted unless a written notice of permission is provided by a parent or by a guardian having legal custody. State issued photo identification of the individual will be requested at the time of dismissal.

The parent claiming custody will be obligated to provide legal evidence to the school principal in the case of a dispute.
