

NAMING & DEDICATION OF ROOMS/BUILDINGS

It is the policy of Wareham Public Schools that buildings, the rooms within those buildings, and the properties associated with those buildings may be named and dedicated, and renamed and rededicated, for individuals or groups that have made an extraordinarily unique or large contribution to Wareham Public Schools. In order to receive such an honor, individuals or groups must:

- In the case of a former employee, have ended his/her employment relationship with Wareham Public Schools at least five (5) years prior to the request for consideration and have been employed by Wareham Public Schools at least ten (10) years.
- Receive the recommendation of the current administrative head of the building (or the building in which the room is located) and the school council of the school, if applicable, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- Be recommended by the current Superintendent of Schools.
- Be approved by the School Committee by a two-thirds (2/3) vote at a regularly scheduled meeting.

Procedures to implement and administer this policy will be developed and amended as necessary by the Superintendent of Schools.
