RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ATTENDANCE—The summer school session is a compact program. Attendance is important, a maximum of TWO EMERGENCY ABSENCES ONLY. Any student whose number of absences exceeds two will be expelled from the course, no refund given.
2. COURT DATES AND DOCTOR APPOINTMENTS are considered as absences and will be counted as such.
3. TARDINESS—students who are tardy must sign in at the office. Three tardies will be counted as an absence.
4. ASSIGNMENTS—Students will have to complete one major project along with class work, homework, tests, and quizzes. Students will be expected to work to capacity and complete assignments given by the teachers.
5. BEHAVIOR—must be above reproach since time cannot be spent for disciplining students. Offenders will be warned once, the parent will be advised, and if misbehavior continues, offenders will be dropped from the course and receive no credit, and no refund.
6. LAVATORIES—students needing to use the lavatories will sign in time on entering and leaving the lavatory.
7. CELL PHONES AND IPODS THAT ARE VISIBLE OR ACTIVATED will be confiscated and returned at the end of the student's school day the first time. Any other time, the student will have to wait until 12 noon to get his phone or IPOD back.
8. PROGRESS REPORTS—will be issued the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th week.
9. REPORT CARDS—will be issued the last day of summer school, if completed, otherwise they will be mailed.
10. NO FOOD OR DRINKS WILL BE ALLOWED AT ANYTIME IN ANY CLASSROOM.

STATE REGULATIONS

11. CLOTHING—proper clothing, including shirts and shoes are to be worn in public buildings. Hats or bandanas are not to be worn in the classroom.
12. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS. Any student attending Wareham Summer School program must observe this policy. The school grounds are clearly posted. Failure to observe this policy will result in immediate expulsion.
