

SENIOR PRIVILEGES

It is the policy of the Wareham School Committee to reward responsible behavior by allowing seniors the privilege of freedom from the normal restrictions of school attendance. It is the view of the Committee, that while Senior Privileges are traditional, they are in fact a privilege and not a right. Therefore, Senior Privileges must be approved by the School Committee annually.

Students may earn privileges with the distribution of report cards, and lose privileges immediately upon the failure to meet any one requirement. Senior Privileges will start on the first day of school senior year based on the 4th quarter grades of junior year. A list of eligible seniors will be published and posted by the Senior Class Dean within one week of report card day.

The student, parents, or guardians cannot grieve the denial of privileges to any student.
